How Missing: Donated in 1982 (when I was a young girl) to the Alabama Sheriff's Girls Ranch in Tallapoosa, Ala., along with two registered appaloosas, a mare and filly. My family did this with the understanding that all 3 horses would receive proper training, and we would have first right to get them back. LIES ... the filly died and the mare and Major were sold to a horse dealer in Alexander (Alec) City within a few months. Exactly what we didn't want! I found the mare. She had a great new owner, but she'd been in poor shape when the farmer in Equality bought her. The dealer said he didn't remember Major, but I don't believe that. I don't believe Major ever left his place ... or if he did, it wasn't to a loving family. PLEASE help me find him! I want to find peace about this. If he is deceased, I need to know. If he has a loving family, then I'm happy for him. If I can, I want to buy him back.
